"BIG DAY OUT"

This year's day trip will take place on **Saturday 11th June 2016.**

Girls (& NB Parents) from U8s & U9s are invited. This year, we are going to Portlaois GAA Club to Play a Big Blitz against Local Clubs.

The plan is to travel by bus to our hosts Portlaois GAA Club, play some camogie, have a packed lunch there (It's most likely that they will provide 'Hang Sambos' and 'Tay' in the great GAA traditional way, but it's best for parents themselves to pre-cater for the U8s and U9s own particular tastes). Then back to the *Roll 'n Bowl* centre in Portlaois for kids activities and quality kids food after, then home on the bus!

We have booked the *Roll 'n Bowl Centre* in Portlaois for our Group and the kids can run riot! There is a café area for parents to escape to. The kids will be able to try a range of all-in activities. Nuggets, chips & drink will be provided for paying kids before we leave for home. (See www.bowlingireland.com)

Approximate schedule and agenda for the day is as follows: -

9.15am Assemble in Faughs, **BUSES LEAVE 9.30am SHARP**, 11.00am Arrive in Portlaois to Play Camogie Matches followed by packed Lunch, 13.45ish Depart for *Roll & Bowl*, 14.00-16.30H Play Activities including Kids meal - 17.30/18.00H approx Arrive back in Faughs.

The all-inclusive cost is **€10 per adult on Bus and €20 per child** (bus is heavily sub-sidised by Faughs GAA). There is no reduction in price for those kids travelling in their parent's car as we want to encourage all playing kids to become part of the social group. Each supervising adult named overleaf **MUST** travel on the Buses, without exception. (Max 4 kids allocated to 1 allocated supervising adult).

Please note that all juveniles travelling must have an accompanying adult to look after them. If parents are not going, you **must** pre-arrange/agree for another travelling parent to look after your child & advise mentors of name on the consent form on the rear of this leaflet. Mentors are not expected to, and are not qualified to, keep track of/look after all kids welfare on the day.

Kids should bring snacks for bus, packed lunch, water, wear their playing gear, clothing appropriate to the Irish summer (sunscreen, shorts, t-shirts, sunglasses, jumpers, jackets, duffel coats, wellingtons, umbrellas, raingear etc).

All Must also Book and Pay for Trip on or before 26th May (Cash is preferred). Children will not be permitted to Travel in the absence of a Parent-Completed Consent Form (See Rear) which must be handed in with the money

Code of Conduct TO BE READ TO KIDS; -

- Bring sun cream and suitable clothing for Irish climate & for activity;
- Wear your club Camogie gear;
- Seat belts are to be worn and no standing on the bus once journey commences;
- Treat each other, members of public and surroundings with respect;
- Report any incidents/accidents to mentors;
- Bin any litter or take it home with you;
- Follow instructions of mentors at all times;
- Personal items eg clothing, money, mobiles etc are brought at own risk, are responsibility of child/guardian and will not be ‘minded’ by mentors. In the event of their loss Faughs accepts no responsibility;
- Ensure you are aware of the programme for the day and be on time;
- Most importantly be a ‘team player’ and have a great day!

NOTE - For parents/guardians who cannot accompany their child please arrange for another parent or mentor to take responsibility for your child on the day. We do want the Girls to attend this important Team-Building Day. These Trips are the most memorable for Kids. Thanks!
